1st Grade School Supplies

Community Supplies (No name needed):

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 3 boxes of Kleenex tissues
- 1 plastic container of disinfectant wipes
- 24 pre-sharpened #2 wooden pencils
- 3 large pink "block" erasers
- 2 wide highlighters (2 different colors)
- 1 box Band-Aids (latex free) **(boys)**
- 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags **(boys)**
- 1 box quart size Ziploc bags **(girls)**
- 1 bottle Germ-X **(girls)**

Personal Supplies (Write child's name):

- 1 box broad tip washable markers
(8 count)
- 3 boxes of crayons

Summer Reading for ELA

Students must also read **1 book** from the "Choose One" reading list.

(BL stands for book level, for example: .6 represents Kindergarten 6th month, 1.5 represents 1st grade 5th month, etc.)

Parents if you child cannot read the book by themselves, please read and discuss the book with them.

Required Book:

- *Whistle for Willie* by Ezra Jack Keats

Choose One:

- Mo books (any series) by David Adler (BL 1.8 and up)
- *Rosie's Walk* by Pat Hutchinson (BL .6)
- *I Went Walking* by Sue Williams (BL .7)
- *Fly Guy* (any from the series) by Tedd Arnold (BL 1.4 and up)
- Young Cam Jansen (any from the series) by David Adler (BL 2.3 and up)

ELA – Students should be able to:

- Answer questions about key details in the book and make connections between the illustrations and text. (*K standards*)

Math – Students should be able to:

- Fluently add and subtract within 5. (*K standard*)
- Solve addition and subtraction word problems, and add and subtract within 10, e.g., by using objects or drawings to represent the problem. (*K standard*)
- Recognize pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters by name and value. (*K standard*)
