Community Supplies (No name needed):

- 2 roll of paper towels

Required Summer Reading for ELA

First graders are to read **1 required book**. This book will be part of a project during the first 3 weeks of school.

Students must also read **1 book from the "Choose One"** reading list.

(BL stands for book level, for example: .6 represents Kindergarten 6th month, 1.5 represents 1st grade 5th month, etc.)

Required Book:

- Henry and Mudge, The First Book by Cynthia Rylant (BL 1.5)

Choose One:

- Rosie's Walk by Pat Hutchinson (BL .6)
- I Went Walking by Sue Williams (BL .7)
- Biscuit (any from the series) by Alyssa Capucilli (BL .8 – 1.4)
- Fly Guy (any from the series) by Tedd Arnold (BL 1.4 and up)
- Pinkerton, Behave! (any from the series) by Steven Kellogg (BL 1.5)
- Young Cam Jansen (any from the series) by David Adler (BL 2.3 and up)

Math

- Students should be able to fluently add and subtract within 5. (*K standard*)
